Agile Scrum is a project management style that combines Agile methodology and Scrum framework.

Key Agile Scrum terminology:

- Scrum Master facilitates and promotes values and principles.
- Product owner communicates with shareholders and helps the team.
- Development team is a cross-functional group of professionals who execute the project.
- Sprint is a time-bound part of the project that ends with a product increment.
- Product backlog is a complete list of tasks that must be done within a project.
- Scrum ceremonies include 5 key Scrum meetings that happen every sprint.
- Scrum artifacts include product backlog, sprint backlog, and product increment.

- Inspection
- Adaptation
